## General Guidelines

**Eligibility is based on Primary Care Physician, household income and liquid assets.**

**Total liquid assets must not exceed \$50,000.**

- **Applicant must be a legal US resident.**
- **Applicant must not have any outside assistance in paying for their prescription drug including:**
  1. **Veterans Administration Benefits**
  2. **Private Insurance**
  3. **Medicaid (Open Case)**

**\* Patients with Medicaid “Spend-downs” and Medicare Part D will be reviewed for individual eligibility**

**\*\* Annual household income must fall at or below established income guidelines\*\***

Once your completed application is received, you will be screened for financial eligibility and for available medication programs for the specific medications you take. Should you meet the conditions for eligibility, our staff will apply for free prescription medications on your behalf. All medications will be obtained directly from pharmaceutical companies or their representatives. Once screened, all applicants will be notified of the programs they are eligible for and will be given an estimated date of arrival for their medications.

**\*\* The MAP program does not distribute or dispense medications; All medications are delivered to the Primary Care Provider’s office.**

**\*\*Processing will be delayed if supporting financial documentation is not received with application materials.**

**\*\* Medication is not guaranteed through MAP. Pharmaceutical companies reserve the right to change or discontinue their assistance at any time.**
